Duration: 6 hrs.

Course outline:

- Anatomy and physiology for phlebotomy
- Medical terminology for phlebotomy
- Patient interaction and related legal, ethical and safety issues
- Patient identification and lab requisition form
- Venipuncture equipment and vacuumed blood collection system
- Safety and universal precautions in handling the samples
- Administrative steps of phlebotomy
- Hands-on practical training on blood and specimen collection
- Preparing blood collection site and proper managing of the collected samples



Objectives:

To learn the fundamentals and essentials of phlebotomy as the procedure relates to patient care. Upon successful completion of this course the student will be able to:

- Explain basic anatomy and physiology of the circulatory system
- Define “standard precautions” related with blood collection and handling
- Practice the use of medical terminology relating to the circulatory system
- List methods of client and specimen identification
- List the different colors used to code blood specimens and what they stand for
- Demonstrate how to dispense blood into tubes following syringe collection
- Outline post-puncture care of the client
- List potential pre-analytical sources of specimen error

Practicum course:

- Practicum course students practice the blood collection and handling skills learned in theory class
- Practice on simulation arms with non-blood specimen collection procedure
- Receive instruction on how to o prepare the blood collection site
- Choose the proper collection tools
- Post-puncture care, processing and management of collected samples
